"ARAISHU" is a bright vermilion color that looks slightly washed, or a light vermilion color.

SHIMBASHI-IRO  
新橋色

The bright, bluish-green color was popular among "Geisha" in Shimbashi / Tokyo as it was fashionable and trendy.

KUROGANEIRO  
鉄色

The color is characterized by a dark, dull, bluish green color, and was used often as the color for store clerk aprons in 1900's.

KUJAKURYOKU  
孔雀緑

"KUJAKURYOKU" had been introduced by the West during the Meiji era. Bluish-green, like the beautiful peacock wings.
